

REGISTER FIRST

All persons are required to register PRIOR to participation in ANY program, unless otherwise stated in the program details. Registrations and fees cannot be handled at the event/class by instructors or any staff members.

Times on events maybe subject to change without notice – refer to the JMBA website for most updated information.

Eligibility where stated: All JMBA members denotes SCJ employees/retirees, Legacy Diversey retirees, affiliate member employees/retirees

ADULT CLASSES

Plan for your children as they will not be permitted in the program/class location and may not be left unsupervised in hallways or locker room areas.

FITNESS CENTER POLICY

JMBA employee/retiree members of SCJ, Legacy Diversey and affiliates and/or their eligible spouse/domestic partner and dependents 13 and over (13 to 15 years old must be supervised by a cardholder 16 and over or have passed the Youth Strength Training program) are eligible to use the facility. Children 12 and under are not permitted in this area.

GENERAL GUEST POLICY

JMBA employee/retiree members of SCJ, Legacy Diversey and affiliates and/or their eligible spouse/domestic partner may bring one guest to use our facilities when we are open, except the Fitness Center; see Guest Fitness Center Policy. Dependents are not eligible to sponsor guests.

GUEST FITNESS CENTER POLICY: FRIDAYS & SUNDAYS ONLY



WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR COURSE

This class provides entry level participants the knowledge and skills to teach swimming lessons by developing their understanding of how to use the course materials, how to conduct training sessions and how to evaluate participants who successfully complete the Water Safety Instructor course, receive an American Red Cross certificate for Water Safety Instructor, valid for 2 years



BABYSITTING TRAINING - 8 A.M. TO 3 P.M.

This training will help participants develop leadership skills; learn how to develop a babysitting business; keep themselves and others safe; help children behave; and learn about basic childcare and basic first aid.



LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSE - 8 A.M. TO 2 P.M.

Provides entry-level participants the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until EMS personnel take over. Participants who successfully complete the lifeguarding course receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED that is valid for 2 years.
